#### Importance of this clinical skill

- Women of color are historically underrepresented in dermatology and gynecology education. Limited educational tools contribute to the challenge of diagnosing vulvovaginal diseases and identifying the different appearances in various populations, particularly women of color.
- This results in highly variable approaches to management and suboptimal therapeutic outcomes for Black and other dark-skinned women
- Very few textbooks or articles in the literature show vulvar diseases on dark skin



# LSIL of the vulva (condylomata acuminata)








60 y.o. female mentions that she has uncomfortable groin itching and pain with intercourse. Her yeast culture is negative.

29 y.o. female if found to have pigmented patches on her vulva




33 y.o. female recently increased their testosterone dose and now notices clitoral enlargement

## Invasive squamous cell carcinoma





45 y.o. female has intense vulvar pruritus. It awakens her at night. A yeast culture was negative. She has been intermittently treated without success with Class I topical steroids for over a year.

## Lipoma





65 y.o. female presents with a chronic, itchy, and erythematous vulvar lesion with a distinct, well-defined margin, not relieved with OTC yeast medications or flucanazole
